

### **Annex 3**

#### **Technical and formal conditions for bilateral Proposal**

1. Proposal must be submitted to the Slovak Research and Development Agency (SRDA) by the deadline defined in the call.
2. Proposal must be submitted to SRDA in the defined form, using SRDA electronic system for project submission.
3. Proposal must also be submitted to SRDA in defined paper version.
4. Submitted proposal in electronic and paper version must be identical.
5. Proposal in paper version must be signed by both participating organizations (signatures of responsible Principal Investigator, statutory). Signatures of foreign partners sent by fax or scanned version will be accepted.
6. The proposal must be submitted parallel in Slovak and in foreign partner site (according to the partner organization instructions).
7. In the frame of this call one person can be in the position of the Principal Investigator only in one project. In the case when he/she submits two or more proposals, SRDA will accept only the one which was submitted first via the electronic information system.
8. If the applicant realized, after submitting the application in the on-line system, that it was not correct, he will submit the new one. This new application will obtain a new identification number. The applicant will inform SRDA in writing about the submission of the correcting application.
9. Any Principal Investigator whose has had a previous project financed by SRDA which was, after completion, evaluated in the Final Evaluation Report as “completed to unsatisfactory level“ is not eligible to submit a further project to SRDA during the period of 3 calendar years from the year when he/she received the Final Evaluation Report.
10. Slovak participant have to provide to SRDA the Licence on Qualification to perform R&D in compliance with the Slovak Act No. 172/2005 Coll. as amended by later regulations in paper version together with the project proposal.
