

ANNEX 1 – TECHNICAL AND FORMAL CONDITIONS

- 1. The following parts of the application must be delivered to the agency **in written within the given deadline:**
 - a) part A4 of the application signed by the principal investigator of the applicant organisation;
 - b) part E of the application signed by the statutory representatives of the applicant organisation.
- 2. Application shall be submitted electronically through the electronic project application system and must contain the following documents **in electronic form** in both Slovak and English:
 - a) part of the application A to E on the prescribed form;
 - b) part of F application on the prescribed form according to the binding scheme for bilateral cooperation.
- 3. In Part C of the application, the amount of funding provided by the agency shall be defined as follows:
 - a) a maximum of EUR 10 000 for the whole project period and EUR 5 000 for a calendar year for 3 participating countries;
 - b) a maximum of EUR 12 500 for the whole project period and EUR 6 250 for a calendar year for 4 participating countries;
 - c) a maximum of EUR 15 000 for the whole project period and EUR 7 500 for a calendar year for 5 participating countries.
 - d) a maximum of EUR 17 500 for the whole project period and EUR 8 750 for a calendar year for 6 and more participating countries.
- 4. The paper-based and electronic versions of the application must be identical.
- 5. The part of the application A4 05 must contain the ID of the researcher, i.e. the unique identifier of the principal investigator from the scientific database WoS Web of Science, Scopus or ORCID.
- 6. Original or officially certified copy of the Letter of Mutual Intent to Cooperate between the applicant and partner organisation in the English language shall be an integral part of the Application in paper form; it must include the number or title of the related project. A sample of the Letter of Mutual Intent to Cooperate between the applicant and partner organisation comprises Annex 5 to the Consolidated Version of the Public Call.
