

- 1. The following parts of the application must be delivered to the agency in written within the given deadline:
 - a) part of the RD-E application signed by the statutory representatives of the applicant organisation,
 - b) part of the RD-E application signed by the statutory representatives of the co-recipient organisations.
- 2. Application shall be submitted electronically through the electronic project application system and must contain the following documents **in electronic form** in both Slovak and English:
 - a) part of the application RD-A to RD-E on the prescribed form,
 - b) part of RD-F application on the prescribed forms according to the binding scheme for basic research, and/or applied research and development.
- 3. The paper-based and electronic versions of the application must be identical.
- 4. In case of the projects indicating direct application of their solution in practice, original or officially certified copy of the Letter of Intent on Application of the Project Findings in practice between the applicant and **each** purchaser of the project findings, **in written**, comprise an integral part of the application, referred to in RD-B 03 of the application, while it must include the number or name of the relevant project. Template of The Letter of Intent on Use of the Project Findings in Practise comprises Annex No. 7 of the Consolidated version of the public call.
- 5. Original or officially certified copy of the Letter of Intent on Mutual Cooperation between the applicant and the partner organisation **in the English language** as prescribed, shall be an integral part of the application **in paper form**, while it must include the number or name of the relevant project. Template of The Letter of Mutual Intent to Cooperate between the applicant and the partner organisation in Practise comprises Annex No. 8 of the Consolidated version of the public call.
