



## ANNEX 1 – TECHNICAL AND FORMAL CONDITIONS

1. The following parts of the application must be delivered to the agency **in written within the given deadline**:
  - a) part RD-A4 of the application signed by the principal investigator of the applicant organisation;
  - b) part RD-E of the application signed by the statutory representatives of the applicant organisation.
  - c) part RD-E of the application signed by the statutory representatives of the co-recipient organisations
2. Application shall be submitted electronically through the electronic project application system and must contain the following documents **in electronic form** in both Slovak and English:
  - a) part of the application RD-A to RD-E on the prescribed form;
  - b) part RD-F application on the prescribed form in Slovak or only in English according to the binding scheme for basic research, or applied research and development. The part RD-F of the application must not exceed the maximum limit of 20 pages<sup>1</sup> for Obligatory scheme for basic research and Obligatory scheme for applied research and development.
  - c) the structured professional resume of the Principal Investigator of project in English and additionally in Slovak.
3. The paper-based part and and the electronic part of the application must be **identical**.
4. The part of the application RD-A4 05 must contain the ID of the researcher, i.e. the unique identifier of the principal investigator from the scientific database WoS - Web of Science, Scopus or ORCID.
5. In case of the projects indicating direct application of their solution in practice, original or officially certified copy of the Letter of Intent on Application of the Project Findings in practice between the applicant and **each** purchaser of the project findings, **in written**, comprise an integral part of the application, referred to in RD-B 04 of the application, while it must include the number or name of the relevant project. Recommended template of The Letter of Intent on Use of the Project Findings in Practise comprises Annex No. 7 of the Consolidated version of the public call.
6. Copy of the Letter of Mutual Intent to Cooperate between the applicant and partner organisation **in the English language** shall be an integral part of the Application **in paper form**; it must include the number or title of the related project. A sample of the Letter of Mutual Intent to Cooperate between the applicant and partner organisation comprises Annex No. 8 to the Consolidated Version of the Public Call.
